Pathways to Impact

Platform

- HCF 1998 Reed Hasting, Founder of Netflix, made a \$100 million commitment to support Black communities in the U.S. \$10 million went to HCF 1998 Bill Bynum's venture Hope Credit Union to fuel economic opportunity in underserved communities across the Deep South.
- HCF 2021 Carly Zakin launched the "Show Us Your Leave" campaign, leading to a public database of paid leave policies of more than 500 Companies to lead the way on bringing more transparency and insight into paid leave policies in the private sector.
- HCF 2014 David Gilboa launched the Pupil's Project at Warby Parker, which has now distributed 227,000 pairs of glasses to students around the country.

Collaborative Action

- In response to the rise in hate crimes against the AAPI community, several Fellows came together to form The Asian American Foundation, while financially supporting TAAF by moving their companies' philanthropic dollars.
- In the wake of George Floyd's death, African American Fellows wrote a letter to corporate America outlining business practices to end systemic racism in the workplace by diversifying the workforce at all levels and through procurement practices.

Movements

- HCF 2001 Kelsey Wirth launched Mother's Out Front, a grassroots organization fighting to enact sustainable policies to fight Climate Change.
- Three Henry Crown Fellows used their entrepreneurial success to redefine business and launched B Corp, built on the simple fact that business impacts and serves more than just shareholders.
